



CALL FOR RESEARCH PROPOSALS ON SOCIAL WORK EDUCATION – THE APASWE AWARDS RESEARCH GRANTS

Research proposals are invited for the *APASWE Research Grant Award* for scholars who are interested to carry out research on social work education and related fields. Full-time scholars who are APASWE member may submit their research proposal for the award of the research grant to the Office of APASWE on or before 30th November 2019. The research has to be completed within a year after being awarded. The amount of the award is USD1000, of which 50% is to be paid in the beginning of the award and the rest will be paid after the submission of final report of the research. The number of the award is ONE.

The intention of the award is to encourage the social work scholars to carry out research on social work education matters, which will help prepare more effective social work pedagogy that would in turn serve the people better in a rapidly changing Asia-Pacific society resultant from the process of globalization and standardization.

The Award Committee members will be appointed by the President of APASWE in consultation with other executive members. The President will be the Chair of the Award Committee. The Committee would review proposals for the award and makes the final decision.

Requirements for submitting the research proposals:

- The CV of the scholar.
- A letter explaining how the candidate considers himself/herself eligible for the award.
- Research proposals should be submitted to the Chair of the Committee, Prof. Dr. Zulkarnain A. Hatta, by 30th November 2019 via apaswe.office@gmail.com and a copy to APASWE Secretary Dr. David Rose drose@unimelb.edu.au

The research proposal should include the following aspects:

- Introduction
- Literature Review
- Objectives
- Methodology
